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

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PREPARATION & BOOKING



1. BE PREPARED

The first step to a fun and safe trip is making sure you are completely prepared. From checking that all your drivers are the proper age to remembering your credit card, the following guidelines will help to make sure you are ready for your trip.

MINIMUM AGE

Each customer and additional driver must meet the Avis minimum age requirement, which varies by location. An additional surcharge may apply for renters under 25 years of age.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

Non-U.S. and non-Canadian residents are required to present a valid driver's license and a passport from their home country. If the information on your driver's license is not written in the classic Latin alphabet, you must also present an International Driver's Permit.*

*For more information, ask your travel operator/travel agent or call Avis. An International Driver's Permit is not acceptable by itself.

ADDITIONAL DRIVERS

3. CHOOSE YOUR COVERAGE

LOSS DAMAGE WAIVER (LDW)

LDW is an optional coverage that reduces or eliminates your financial responsibility for all loss and damage to your Avis vehicle, due to: collision, theft, vandalism or any other cause. Remember, LDW is not insurance. If you do not accept LDW, you are responsible for all loss or damage.

EMERGENCY SICKNESS PROTECTION (ESP)

Only available in the U.S.

ESP provides international renters with a non-U.S. passport with coverage for certain medical expenses occurring during the rental period. ESP also covers all members of the traveling party.

ADDITIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE (ALI)

Only available in the U.S.

ALI is a special optional service that provides additional liability insurance within specified limits above the limits provided in the Avis Rental Agreement. ALI protects you and authorized operators against claims made by third parties against you for bodily injury/death and property damage caused by operation of an Avis vehicle.

PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE (PAI)

If you are in an accident during the rental, as a driver or passenger, this option will cover accidental death and medical expenses resulting from accidental injury in the U.S. In Canada, it covers accidental death and accidental dismemberment only.

PERSONAL EFFECTS PROTECTION (PEP)

PEP is optional coverage for your personal belongings. PEP insures all members of the renter's traveling party against risks of physical loss or damage to the insured property during your rental.

ENHANCED LIABILITY INSURANCE (ELI)

Only available in British Columbia-Canada.

Provides the renter with \$4,000,000 of automobile liability insurance in addition to the minimum liability protection limits required by law under the Avis rental agreement (\$1 million). ELI insures the renter and authorized drivers against claims made by any third party against the customer for bodily injury, death and property damage caused during the rental.

Your rate or package may include one or more of these coverages, so please check with your tour operator/travel agent.

Stay on track with audible turn-by-turn, point-to-point directions. Our GPS is complete with a touch screen, 3D map, more than 40 languages and much more.

Avis e-Toll™

Only available in the U.S.

Keep your trip moving by paying for tolls through the electronic toll lanes. Electronic toll lanes allow you to pay tolls through a device in your car instead of paying a toll collector. It's important to note that the names of electronic toll lanes vary by state, so look for signs signaling electronic payment. Avis e-Toll is already installed in most vehicles, so just ask for an e-Toll enabled car when making reservations.

Avis e-Receipt™

Avis proudly offers the convenience of keeping your rental paperless. Within minutes of your return, we'll e-mail a receipt right to your inbox. Simply supply your e-mail address at the time of rental.

Emergency Roadside Service (ERS)

For everything from mechanical problems to no spare tires, emergency assistance is available 24/7. Simply call toll-free **1-800-354-2847** to be connected to a service provider who will be dispatched to handle the problem. Additional charges may apply for other services such as fuel delivery, jump start, key replacement and lock out service.

Ski racks

If your trip includes a trip to the slopes, ski racks are available at select Avis locations in the northeastern and western U.S. and Canada.

Child safety seats

Keep your children safe by adding baby or child seats to your rental. Our wide range of safety seats ensures a safe trip for all your little ones. It is required by law to use safety seats when traveling with infants and children. Make sure to check before traveling.

Access Services People with Disabilities

This special service includes hand controls, spinner knobs and swivel seats. Select locations also feature oversized mirrors with advance reservations.

Roadside SafetyNet (RSN)

For added security, for a small daily surcharge, RSN will cover those rather expensive services that ERS does not, including key replacement and lock out service.

RETURNING YOUR CAR

Follow the signs for Avis car return when entering the airport lot.

- Take your car to the designated return area.
- Enter your mileage/kilometers, whether you purchased fuel during your rental and the fuel level on the front of your Rental Agreement.
- Give the Rental Agreement to the Avis representative.
- Receive a copy of your return receipt.

Any additional charges, such as sales tax, fuel service fee, etc., will be charged to your credit card.

RAPID RETURN®

For a faster, more convenient return, when available use Rapid Return. Instead of going to the rental counter, an Avis representative may meet you right at your car. Using a handheld return system, your receipt will be printed in seconds.

AVIS ONE-WAY SERVICE

If you are not traveling round-trip, Avis One-Way allows for car return in a different location than pickup. Speak with your travel agent or Avis representative about one-way travel options. See Mileage Distances Chart for U.S cities on pages 34–35 and Canadian cities on pages 36–37.

AVIS ALWAYS TRIES HARDER

If you realize that you have left a personal item behind, call the Avis location where you dropped off your car as soon as possible.

You can find the phone number easily on your rental agreement. Our staff will personally check the vehicle for your missing item.

The earlier you report your item lost, the sooner we can help you find it.




TRAVEL TIPS

- Familiarize yourself with the car before leaving the lot:
 - Adjust your mirrors
 - Adjust your seat
 - Locate all the gauges, window controls, lights, wipers, air/heat controls, etc.
- Ask Avis for directions. You may obtain directions and/or a map from an Avis Rental Sales Agent, an Avis® Preferred® Service Representative or the Exit Gate Attendant. Better yet, rent a *where2*® GPS for audible turn-by-turn directions.
- Obey all signs/speed limits.
- If your vehicle is bumped from behind, do not stop on the roadway or shoulder unless safe to do so. Drive to the nearest public area and call for police assistance. For emergency, dial 911.
- If advised by another motorist of problems with your vehicle, do not stop until reaching a service station or well-populated area.
- Do not stop for flashing white lights. Lights on U.S. and Canadian emergency vehicles are red or red and blue.
- Do not pick up hitchhikers under any circumstances.
- Driving Under the Influence (DUI) of alcohol or drugs is against the law and is considered a very serious offense in the U.S. and Canada. It is a violation of the Rental Agreement if you drive under the influence.
- Remember that wearing seat belts and using child safety seats for infants and small children is mandatory in all U.S. states and Canadian provinces.
- Talking and texting on mobile phones and other personal communication devices while driving is illegal in many states and most big cities, unless the driver is using a hands-free device. Check for local restrictions.
- If your car is not operating properly, drive to a well-lit area before stopping. Call Avis Emergency Roadside Assistance: **1-800-354-2847**.
- If someone on the road indicates that they need assistance, do not stop. Instead, obtain a description and notify the authorities/police. For emergency, dial 911.
- If you are lost, and your vehicle is equipped with *where2*® GPS, please utilize this service. Otherwise, find a nearby gas station, police station or public place and ask for assistance.
- Keep all doors and windows locked at all times.
- Stow all valuables out of sight.
- Park only in a lighted area. Always check the interior and exterior of your vehicle before you enter.



UNDERSTANDING ROAD SIGNS



Steady Red—Stop; do not go until the light is green.

Flashing Red—Stop; yield the right-of-way and go when it is safe.

Steady Yellow—Light changing to red; be ready to stop.

Flashing Yellow—Caution.

Steady Green—Go.

Green Arrow—Proceed in that direction.

In some states/provinces, unless otherwise posted, you may make a *right turn* at a steady red light after coming to a *full stop* and yielding the right-of-way to oncoming traffic.






